

Summary of Proposed 2022 By-Law changes

- **General changes**
 - Changed Executive Committee throughout to Leadership Council
 - Various minor changes throughout
 - Changed timing of procedures to reflect current trends
 - Changed “spouse” to “partner” throughout

- **Specific changes** (Sections refer to current By-Laws dated (November 2014))
 - Article I – Added: “or Sisterhood” to the end of the Statement
 - Article VII
 - Section A
 - Removed Corresponding Secretary
 - Added at the end “In the event that the president cannot be filled, the Leadership Council shall collectively fulfill the duties of the President. Additionally, if there’s no retiring president than any past President can be nominated as Counselor.”
 - Section B – changed language
 - Section C – changed “at least 75% of” to “the majority of”
 - Section H – added “if necessary to the end
 - Article IX – Changed wording to describe current responsibilities
 - Section D – removed as there is no need for a corresponding secretary
 - Section F – timing changes
 - Article X
 - Section A – added detail and timing changes
 - Section D & E – Combined and clarified as to time and details
